



Directors in attendance: Peter Mason (President), Joe McCluan (1st VP), Denise Ertler (2nd VP), Michelle Deleon, Fran Frataccia, Jim Kiger; Directors absent: Colby Roof (Treasurer), Melissa Johnson, Shanon Larimer, Mayba Torres; WPPCA Committee Members in attendance: Carol Magierski: WPPCA Members in attendance: Paul Olesen; WPPCA Non-Members in attendance: None; Guests in attendance: None

Meeting called to order by WPPCA President, Peter Mason at 7:39 pm. A quorum was present. All made introductions.

Officer Reports: President: Peter Mason thanked everyone for volunteering. Becky Clisch has resigned as a Director but will stay on as an Events Committee Member. Laurie Davis & Matt Noe have resigned as Committee Members. Tonio Bianca has joined as an Events Committee Member. We still need more members on Events, Membership, Code Enforcement & New Neighbor Welcome Committees. We have 35 Gold and 4 Platinum Members so far. We have a full team for the WPPCA Adopt-A-Precinct for the March 2024 elections. Based on the recent BOD survey we will keep the monthly meetings as they are on the 2nd Wednesday of each month at 7:30 PM via Zoom. We may consider have another hybrid in-person/Zoom meeting later this year. A survey is out for the date of the next Social Gathering for Directors and Committee Members Plus 1. We had a large group helping put up the Mall decorations on 11/25/23 which look great especially at night. Peter is working on a Document Retention and Destruction Policy. Peter had 3 residents contact him this past month about school redistricting (none for Orange County), noise from lawn & landscape companies before 11 am, when holiday decoration judging dates were and number of renters in the Pines, which is currently about 10%.

Secretary: Peter Mason reported as the Acting Secretary. The motion to approve the WPPCA Board of Directors Annual Meeting minutes of 11/8/23 was unanimously approved via DocuSign. Peter asked for any written reports to be sent to him in advance. We are looking for a full time Secretary.

Treasurer: Peter Mason reported on behalf of Colby Roof. November 2023 had Total Income @ \$15, Total Expenses @ \$2,842 and NOI @ (\$2,827). Year to Date Total Income @ \$27,431, Total Expenses @ \$29,748 and NOI @ (\$2,317). The total bank balance was \$14,615. Motion: Jim Kiger moved to accept the Treasurer's report as presented. Denise Ertler seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously with no abstentions.

1st Vice President: Joe McCluan said Orange County has told him our next grant availability is not for another fiscal year, but will be confirming that information.

2nd Vice President: Denise Ertler said she had nothing to report.

Committee Reports: Code Enforcement: Fran Frataccia reported the following 5 incidents including camper in driveway, WPP & speed limit sign missing, robbery, theft and

vandalism.

Digital: Jim Kiger said the website had 122 unique visitors. Jim has been updating the website with sponsors and events. Jim said he has not spent much time on Facebook yet but is monitoring it. Joe McCluan said that it has been the same normal traffic on Nextdoor.

Events: Michelle Deleon said Yoga was held at the Winter Pines Golf Club on 12/2/23, from 9-10 am with 4 participants. They are the 1st Saturday of each month. The Community Happy Hour Meet-Up was held on 12/7/23 at the Bonfire Grill at Winter Pines Golf Club from 6 pm to 8 pm with about 25 people. Plan is to continue to hold them quarterly.

Mall Maintenance: Fran Frataccia said there are problems with the lights in the first median in the Mall area that our electrician is working on. The electrician has upgraded the electrical behind the sign with new boxes, breakers and photocell. Bushes are being trimmed by our landscaper.

Membership: Peter Mason reported for Melissa Johnson. A letter was sent to 836 unpaid members reminding them to pay with 104 resulting payments received with a dollar ROI of 763%. The membership statics are: Membership dollars @ \$11,265, # of members @ 163, % of homes paid @ 19.2%. Electronic payment data capture & paying for processing fees is an unresolved issue.

Needles: Denise Ertler said the last issue had to be re-printed due to a printing error. We will be receiving a credit of \$744 due to a 2023 overcharge by the printer. Peter Mason is the Acting Needles Sponsor Coordinator until we find someone. Peter sent 79 solicitations for Needles Sponsors and have received interest from 9 folks so far with 7 that have paid.

New Neighbor Welcome: Mayba Torres informed Peter Mason that she will be stepping down as the Committee Chair but will stay on as a Director still working on the committee. Peter will be the Acting New Neighbor Welcome Chair until we find someone. Mayba did not send anything to report.

Yard of the Month: Peter Mason reported on behalf of Shanon Larimer that the following December holiday winners were: 1st to Beau & Katie Wingfield at 210 Friar Road; 2nd to Steve & Melodie Mihailoff at 2855 Will O Th Green; 3rd to Armando & Carmen Sanchez at 367 St Dunstan Way.


